

**WHITE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

**MINUTES OF THE CALLED MEETING HELD**

**THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2021 AT 8:00 A.M.**

The White County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Thursday, February 18, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. in the Board Room at the White County Administration Building. Present for the meeting were: Chairman Travis Turner, Commissioner Terry Goodger, Commissioner Lyn Holcomb, Commissioner Edwin Nix, Commissioner Craig Bryant, County Manager Jason Cobb, Finance Director Jodi Ligon, and County Clerk Shanda Murphy.

Chairman Turner called the meeting to order.

Mr. Jason Cobb presented an agreement submitted for consideration from Georgia Power for the installation of two (2) electric vehicle-charging stations at Freedom Park. He stated that this would be no cost to the county and that Georgia Power had accepted the county's current insurance limits. Chairman Turner asked that Mr. Cobb confirm with Georgia Power if there would be any issue if the county needed to relocate the charging stations in the future.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Nix, seconded by Commissioner Holcomb there was a unanimous vote to approve the agreement with Georgia Power for the installation of two (2) electric vehicle charging stations at Freedom Park.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Holcomb, seconded by Commissioner Nix there was a unanimous vote to enter into Executive Session in order to discuss matters of personnel and real estate.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Bryant, seconded by Commissioner Goodger there was a unanimous vote to exit Executive Session.

Commissioner Nix exited the meeting.

Ms. Murphy was not advised to return to the open meeting.

Chairman Turner advised the Board that Sheriff Kelley would be requesting a portable x-ray machine for the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget.

Commissioner Holcomb advised the Board of a possible code enforcement issue at Westmoreland Road & Brookwood.

The proposed nuisance ordinance was discussed and Mr. Cobb was instructed to incorporate a paragraph used in the Hall County's nuisance ordinance in White County's draft ordinance for future consideration.

The Board discussed the preparation of local legislation to increase the Board of Commissioner's compensation by adding a per meeting payment similar to that of Hall County. Mr. Cobb would work with the County Attorney to prepare the draft legislation and bring back to the Board at a later date.
