The White County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting (for the purpose of considering the adoption of the 2010 millage rate) on Thursday, July 29, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. in the Grand Jury Room of the White County Courthouse. Present at the meeting were: Chairman Travis Turner, Commissioner Joe Campbell, Commissioner Craig Bryant, County Manager Carol Jackson, Interim Finance Director Vicki Mays, and County Clerk Shanda Smallwood.

Chairman Turner called the meeting to order.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Commissioner Bryant there was a unanimous vote to adopt the following County Resolution (Number 2010-17) setting the 2010 millage rate for White County (County, State, school, and School Bond) thereby providing authorization for the Chairman to execute:

- Pt 32.1 Form, Computation Of Millage Rate Rollback And Percentage Increase In Property Taxes - 2010;
- Pt 35, County Millage Rate Certification For Tax Year 2010; and
- Certification of Insurance Premium Tax Being Used For Fire Protection In The Unincorporated Area Of White County.

WHEREAS, the White County Board of Commissioners is the taxing Authority of White County; and

WHEREAS, the digest for the taxable year 2010 has been established; and

WHEREAS, the White County Board of Commissioners has adopted a budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, wherein there is included a portion of revenues to be derived from property taxes; and

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WHEREAS, the White County Board of Education has approved an M&O millage rate for the taxable year 2010, along with a school bond millage rate;

NOW, THEREFORE, the White County Board of Commissioners hereby sets the taxable year 2010 millage rate for the incorporated and unincorporated areas as follows:

County portion	.009190;
State portion	.000250;
School portion	.014650; and
School Bond portion	<u>.000339.</u>
Total	<u>.024429.</u>
