MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2010 AT 4:30 P.M.

On Monday, September 13, 2010 the White County Board of Commissioners met held a Regular Meeting at 4:30 P.M. in the Grand Jury Room of the White County Courthouse. Present at the meeting were: Chairman Travis Turner, Commissioner Joe Campbell, County Manager Carol Jackson, and Finance Director Vicki Mays. Commissioner Craig Bryant and County Clerk Shanda Smallwood were not in attendance.

Chairman Turner called the meeting to order.

Following the pledge of allegiance, Dean Dyer provided the invocation.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Chairman Turner there was a unanimous vote to adopt the minutes of the Regular Meeting held August 2, 2010, the Public Hearing held August 16, 2010, the Called Meeting held August 19, 2010 (including sealed Executive Session minutes regarding real estate), the Called Meeting held August 25, 2010 (including sealed Executive Session minutes regarding real estate), and the Called Meeting held August 30, 2010.

Upon presentation of proclamation October 3-9, 2010 was declared Fire Prevention Week in White County.

Upon presentation of proclamation, Shoal Creek Baptist Church was commended in the celebration of the church's 175th anniversary.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Chairman Turner there was a unanimous vote to approve the following consent agenda:

- Approval the Tax Release Application filed by William Havlen (Map & Parcel 047A-075A) Located At 676 Church Street Cleveland, GA for the 2010 Tax Year with taxes to be reduced and based on vacant lot only;
- Approval for designation of Title I Funds for roads with Title III Funds to be Designated at a later date if needed;
- Approval of the award of the 12 month propane supply bid to Blossman Gas at \$1.289 per gallon for all (applicable) county owned facilities;
- Adoption of a resolution authorizing the sale of property seized in 2009 and awarded to White County for Law Enforcement use and located at 237 Old Nacoochee Road, contingent upon Superior Court approval and in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 16-13-49;
- Approval of the process required for The Short Term Work Program Update to be conducted by Tom O'Bryant, Director Of Community & Economic Development;
- Approval for Tom O'Bryant to develop a Bicycle Pedestrian Plan for White County;

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- Approval of The Georgia Department of Transportation's revision to White County's Highway Functional Classification System, with the request that the re-classification of Westmoreland Road be reviewed for consideration;
- Approval for Ridge Road culvert repairs – with project labor to be bid and awarded at a later date – and funding to be paid from the 2008 SPLOST Account; and
- Approval of bid award to Precision Paving and Sealing, Inc. for repair and sealing of the parking area and driveway at Station 2 (Leaf Community) and partial repair of the walking track– with funds to be paid from the Fire Fund Contingency.

-End of Consent Agenda-

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Chairman Turner there was a unanimous vote to reallocate funds previously designated from the Solid Waste SPLOST (\$60,000.00) to now be designated from the 2008 SPLOST for the purchase of the Truelove Road property in the total amount of \$135,000.00

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Chairman Turner there was a unanimous vote to approve a resolution (County Resolution No. 2010-26) declaring various information technology equipment as surplus thereby authorizing the on-line sale of equipment via Go-Deals.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of White County have determined that certain County-owned property is surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of White County desires to dispose of said property through the government on-line auction and to give public notice of said disposition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of White County, Georgia, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

The Board of Commissioners of White County hereby declares that the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is surplus and shall be disposed of by the county by government on-line auction to the highest responsible bidder for each item. All surplus personal property will be sold "as is" and must be removed from the county property by the successful bidder within ten (10) days from the award of the bid, except as otherwise provided in Exhibit "A."

The Board of Commissioners of White County reserves the right to refuse any and all bids on said property.

The County Manager is hereby authorized to execute any title transfers and bills of sale to the successful bidders on the personal property.
